

## STATUTE – V

### ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION AGAINST 20% SEATS RESERVED FOR RESIDENT STUDENTS OF ANDHRA PRADESH AT NALSAR

S 5.01. In exercise of the powers under Section 10(1)(ii) of NALSAR University Act, 1998, this Statute has been framed prescribing the procedure for admission against 20% seats reserved for “resident students” of Andhra Pradesh across all categories in the courses at NALSAR provided for under Section 5A incorporated by National Academy of Legal Studies and Research University (Amendment) Act, 2010.

#### S 5.02. Definitions:

In this Statute, unless the context otherwise requires:

- a) “**Act**” means National Academy of Legal Studies and Research University (Amendment) Act No. 6 of 2010.
- b) “**Courses**” means such courses in which limited number of seats are offered by NALSAR which include 5-year B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) Course and LL.M. Course.
- c) “**Resident Student**” of Andhra Pradesh means:
  - i) a student who or any one of his parents has resided in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a period of atleast four years; or
  - ii) a student who has studied in any one of the educational institutions in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a period of not less than four years leading to the qualifying examination.

S 5.03. A resident student, in order to be eligible for admission to the courses, should have passed the qualifying examination from any educational institution in Andhra Pradesh and should also secure appropriate rank in order of merit in the Common Law Admission Test.

S 5.04. The allocation of seats in the aforementioned courses shall be as follows:

- a. Ten seats have been earmarked for admission of Foreign Nationals out of the total of Eighty seats available in 5-year B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) course.
- b. Seventy seats available in 5-year B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) Course shall be filled in through CLAT and distribution across various categories – general and reserved including 20% seats for resident students of A.P. – shall be as below:

- c. For the Master of Laws (LL.M.) Programme, out of the total of 60 seats, 10 seats are earmarked for Foreign Nationals.
- d. Remaining 50 seats shall be filled in through CLAT and distribution across various categories – general and reserved including 20% seats reserved for resident students of Andhra Pradesh is as below:

S 5.05. All other Rules regarding eligibility for admission and Qualifying Marks in qualifying exam and CLAT shall be as prescribed in the Admission Regulations from time to time.

- S 5.06. A.P. Resident Students shall submit:
- a. a certificate of atleast four years' residence in Andhra Pradesh either of self or any one of parents, and such certificate shall be issued by Tahisildar / Mandal Revenue Officer; and
  - b. a study certificate and the marks statement of the qualifying examination issued by the Board / University / educational institution in Andhra Pradesh as a proof of his / her having passed the qualifying examination from a college / institution in Andhra Pradesh.
  - c. Candidate belonging to S.C. / S.T. of Andhra Pradesh shall also submit the caste certificate issued by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.

S 5.07. If a resident student of Andhra Pradesh, qualifies for admission in the regular all India merit, he / she shall be considered against the All India Seat only and not against A.P. Quota Seat.

- S 5.08. a. If no candidate is available against the seats reserved for resident students of Andhra Pradesh, such seats shall be added to the relevant categories under All India Quota.
- b. The vacant seats of Persons with Disability Category and also the Foreign National Category shall be offered to the All India General Category Candidates only in order of merit.

S 5.09 In future, if the number of total available seats in aforesaid courses i.e. 5-year B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) and LL.M. in various categories are increased or decreased, as the case may be, the distribution / allocation of seats in different categories shall be altered accordingly or as per Laws and Rules in force at the time.
