Dear Parents,

Within a short period of 11 years, NALSAR has emerged as one of the best Law Schools in the country and you could be proud of the fact that your son/daughter is a student of NALSAR. Moreover, reporting back to campus after 7.00 p.m., staying out on the campus in breach of Hostel Rules beyond 9.00 p.m. exposes them to physical risk and exposure to bad influence of alcoholics, drug addicts etc.

Any violation of campus Discipline Rules, lack of commitment to studies and other acts of indiscipline by your son/daughter are likely to impair and adversely impact his/her professional and individual growth. Possession or use of Tobacco, Alcohol, Contraband drugs in any form whatsoever is totally prohibited. Such acts of indiscipline shall invite serious disciplinary action and punishments including fines, expulsion from hostel and/or rustication/expulsion from NALSAR.

This is to advise you to counsel your son / daughter regarding strict compliance of the Rules of Campus Discipline.

You are further advised to visit NALSAR and meet the wardens and faculty members to know about the progress of your son/daughter and to ensure compliance of discipline Rules and higher commitment to studies and professional growth. Your child is your most precious asset and therefore, please, invest your time in his / her growth. You are the most important participant / stake-holder in his / her professional education and character-building.
