**REVISED DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS IN VARIOUS CATEGORIES  
FOR B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) & LL.M.  
(Academic Session 2010 – 2011)**

In view of A.P. Ordinance No. 3 of 2010, twenty percent of the seats are reserved for the candidates who pass the qualifying examination from educational institutions in A.P. from the Academic Session 2010 – 2011 in 5-year B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) and 2-year LL.M. Programmes at NALSAR. The revised distribution of seats is as given below:

**5-year B.A., LL.B. (Hons.)**

Out of 80 seats, 10 seats are reserved for Foreign Nationals and 70 seats shall be filled on the basis of merit in CLAT-2010 in various categories as per details below:

**2-year LL.M. (Master of Laws)**

Out of 60 seats, 10 seats are reserved for Foreign Nationals and 50 seats shall be filled on the basis of merit in CLAT-2010 in various categories as per details below:

- The candidates who pass the qualifying examination from the educational institutions in A.P. shall be considered under the State Quota.
- The resident students of A.P. who get selected in the regular merit will be considered against All-India-Seats and those who do not get regular merit seat in All-India-Seats shall be considered against the State-Quota-Seats in different categories in order of merit in CLAT-2010.
- Candidates of A.P. belonging to S.C. / S.T. should submit the Caste Certificate issued by the Government of A.P. only.
- The vacant seats under Foreign National Category shall be filled by the All India General Category candidates in order of merit.

**Note :** NALSAR reserves the right to cancel admission of any candidate under any category if it is found that he / she is not fulfilling the requirements for that particular category or has secured admission by furnishing wrong information.

**Instructions to candidates:**

Candidates who have passed / are appearing in the qualifying examination in the educational institutions in A.P. are required to download the following Proforma and submit duly filled-in Proforma along with CLAT-Application-Form to the Convenor, CLAT-2010, NLIU, Bhopal.

Candidates who have already submitted their CLAT-2010-Application-Form are also required to submit the Proforma mentioning their Application Number for consideration under the A.P. State Quota.
